

Vladimir Mihajlovic, PhD

BIOGRAPHY

Vladimir Mihajlovic was born on 3th June 1984 in Kraljevo. He finished elementary and secondary school for tourism in Vrnjacka Banja with honors. He enrolled Faculty of Economics, University of Kragujevac in 2003, and graduated on 7th September 2007, with the GPA 9.03/10.00. He has been awarded several times by Faculty of Economics for success in studying.

He entered PhD studies at Faculty of Economics in 2008, major Economics, module Macroeconomics. He passed all exams with GPA 10.00/10.00. On 21th September 2017 he defended PhD thesis, entitled “Theoretical and Empirical Evaluation of the New Neoclassical Synthesis”.

Vladimir Mihajlovic was elected in 2010 for teaching associate on course units Economic Doctrines and Macroeconomic Analysis and for teaching assistant in 2012. In the same year, he was elected for teaching assistant on course unit Controversies in Macroeconomics, on Master academic studies. In 2018, he was elected for assistant professor on course units Economic Doctrines and Macroeconomic Analysis.
